
In addition, Styria holds a top position among Europe's regions with an R&D rate of around 5 percent, and life sciences is one of the location's strengths.

These framework conditions have proven to be an ideal breeding ground for entrepreneurship and have created a lasting pull effect for the science and business location since the opening of the ZWT in 2014. This is reflected in the newly settled start-ups and the dynamic development of the current ZWT tenants (see page 4). The promotion of entrepreneurship will continue to be a central objective of the Medical University of Graz, which is now bundling its activities in the new ZWT Accelerator. This new life science hotspot is currently being built as a "gateway to the Medical Science City Graz" and is aimed both at start-ups and spin-offs from the life science sector, as well as international companies that carry out life science research projects together with the Medical University of Graz.
